### Welcome to The Carlton Academy

We are highly a successful and oversubscribed school of 900 students and are sponsored by the Redhill Academy Trust. Our school was last inspected by OFSTED in May 2017 and we were judged as being a 'good school'. The inspection report states that:

*'The school is characterised by pupils who are well behaved, both in lessons and at other times around the school. There is a culture of respect and pupils are polite to each other and to adults. Staff expect pupils to achieve well and, as a parent rightly stated, 'Carlton Academy sets high expectations of its students.'*

In addition, the report says:

*"The points for improvement identified in the report following the inspection in 2013 have been tackled successfully. You have worked hard to eliminate less effective teaching and to ensure that teachers plan lessons that stretch and support pupils. Standards are now higher in many subject areas, including English and mathematics, and you now use the information you collect more effectively to support and challenge pupils with their learning"*

### Overview of the Faculty / Department

#### Outcomes

Outcomes for all students have continued to rise in KS3 and in KS4 areas both across the academy and within our subject area. The team is focused on ensuring that we continue this very positive trend and continue to recruit more pupils into Key Stage 5 courses in our subject area. #### Facilities

We have good indoor facilities which include sports hall, gymnasium, fitness suite and a table tennis room. The academy is continuing to invest in our outdoor facilities and receives good levels of funding from the Redhill Trust to ensure we keep all of our sports venues up to date. We have a designated PE classroom where we teach the majority of our classroom lessons. We also have access to a computer suite for any coursework based lessons.

#### Curriculum

The PE department deliver a broad sporting curriculum offer which is constantly updated to suit the needs of all our students. We have a high uptake in KS4 courses at GCSE and BTEC level as well as students opting for KS5 courses in the sixth form. Student voice surveys have suggested that the majority of pupils enjoy PE lessons and our participation rate in this subject is extremely high.

#### Network and CPD offer

We benefit from and contribute to the wide CPD offer in the academy and also the Trust subject networks. Working in partnership with other subject leaders and teachers provides us with the opportunity to share expertise and ensure we are continually able to reflect and further improve all that we do in order to raise the achievement of students.

#### Enrichment

The PE department, other school staff and coaches run an extensive extra-curricular programme with a wide variety of activities for students to participate in both at lunchtime and after school. We also enter many fixtures and sports events throughout the year with success most notably in Handball.
