Exam Results 2021

I am writing to you outlining the process for the collection of exam results this summer. As you know, grades this year are based on Teacher Assessed Grades (TAGs). TAGs were submitted to the exam boards by us as a holistic assessment of students' performance in a subject, following a rigorous process of assessment, moderation and quality assurance. Exam boards have taken samples of our students' work in a range of subjects and qualifications to ensure that it meets external quality assurance criteria before they award qualifications this summer.

All students took home a record of the evidence we used in each of their subject areas to calculate their TAG grades. Where students were absent, these records were posted home.

Each year students receive their results on the same day as their peers. Results day this year will take place earlier than usual in August as follows:

A Levels and Level 3 Vocational Qualifications

A Level results day will be on Tuesday 10 August 2021. Students are invited to come in to school to collect their results from 8:30am onwards. Support with destinations and using the clearing process for university applications will be available on the day.

GCSEs and Level 2 Vocational Qualifications

GCSE results day will be on Thursday 12 August 2021 as follows:

- Year 11 students are invited to collect their results from 9.00am
- Year 12 and 13 Maths and English resit students are invited to collect their results from 9.00am
- Year 10 students are invited to collect their results from 10.00am

Support with Sixth Form applications and post 16 destinations will be available on the day.

All students are asked to come in to school at the allocated time through the main student entrance next to the staff car park, and to make their way up to the Open Area in the main school to collect their results.

We are really looking forward to sharing what we know will be a real celebration of success with our exam group students, after what has been a challenging exam year.
