- Need to be able to complete Calculator past papers at home.



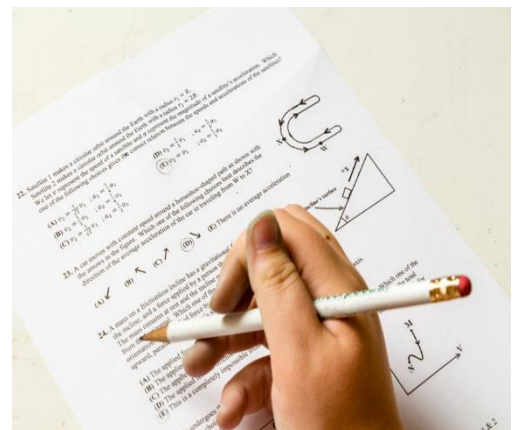


Hegarty maths is a great resource for all students. It can be used in a variety of ways:

1. Homework- Pupils will be set at least one piece of homework a week on Hegarty which they should complete in their Hegarty maths book.
2. Feedback- After MOCK exams pupils will be given a variety of videos on topics they have not mastered on the exam.
3. Memri- 10 questions quizzes to ensure students retain the topics they have learnt.
4. Fix up 5- deliberate practice of topics that students haven't performed as well at.
5. Hegarty: essential stop offs: Each student will receive a list of topics that will be essential to achieving the grade they are aiming for. Students should be able to get 100% on these topics

- Every Tuesday after school (starting after the Christmas holidays).
- Compulsory Period 6
- Completing past papers well has been proven to raise exam grade.
- Pupils will complete a past paper one week.
