Year 10 Mock Exams

Further to my letter to you last week, I can now confirm that Year 10 mock examinations will take place across 2 weeks commencing on 21 June 2021. The exams will cover the subject areas students will take through to Year 11, they will not be examined in RE and their option subject that completes this year. Students will commence their Year 11 programme of study on the 14 June once the process of evidence gathering for their early entry courses has completed, giving them maximum time in their remaining subjects.

Teachers will provide students with a list of topics they must revise in preparation for these exams and will ensure students have sufficient revision materials to enable them to prepare fully for these. Students will be supported in their lessons after half term to ensure they are equipped with the necessary skills and techniques for answering exam questions.

Below you will find full details of the exams schedule. A copy of this timetable will be given to your child today. All students will sit English, Maths and Science exams as well as exams in their chosen areas of study. If students are not part of a particular exam, they will attend their lessons as normal. There will not be mock exams in some of the vocational courses, where it is not appropriate due to the nature of the course and the way it is assessed.
