Dear Parent

Detailed below is the plan in relation to Covid-19 asymptomatic testing for students, lessons and students returning to school. This is a complex process and I very much appreciate you taking the time to read this carefully. A more detailed letter will be sent to you on Tuesday 2 March in relation to the re-opening of school.

In order to test students, there will need to be some days where there is a reduction in online learning to enable students to come into school. Those students not being tested should use this time for catch up work.

Detailed below, you will see the outline for each day from Monday 1 March to Monday 15 March. This document outlines the learning provision for each day along with which students are being tested and when. It also shows that we have managed to organise this plan so that **Years 12 and 13 return to school on Monday 8 March** and **all other students return to school on Tuesday 9 March**.

You will note on this plan, that on **Friday 5 March**, there will not be any live lessons at all. All work for this day will be set on Satchel One for Years 7-11 and Post 16 teachers will direct students in advance. This day is being used to undertake mass staff testing and preparation for students returning to site.

Testing

All testing between Wednesday 1 March and Monday 8 March will involve students arriving at school at the times stated below. It is important students arrive at the correct time to remain in year groups. Testing undertaken after Tuesday 9 March will be done as part of the school day.

Students do not need to wear school uniform whilst attending for testing before Tuesday 9 March. Once they have had their test, they will leave the site and are expected to go straight home ready for their online lessons. It would be very helpful if students come to school knowing the following information that they will be asked as part of the registration process:

- **Their date of birth**
- **First line of their home address and postcode**
- **The mobile number of a parent to whom the test result is sent**
- **Their ethnicity (optional)**

Once we have completed three tests for all students who have consented, we will begin providing home testing kits for your child. Further information will be sent to you shortly.

Further details in relation to school re-opening will be communicated to you on Tuesday 2 March.
