Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to you as we are coming close to Modern Foreign Languages trip to Valencia, which is taking place Monday 10 June – Friday 14 June 2019. An Itinerary is attached for your son/daughter that outlines the details of the trip, timings and accommodation details.

As the trip is an overnight stay, we believe it would be in the best interests of the students to bring the following list of essentials for the trip:-

- Passports & EHIC cards (**to bring into school ASAP if not already done so**)
- Appropriate footwear suitable for long distance walking (trainers)
- Weather permitting clothing e.g. waterproof coat
- Four changes of clothes
- Toiletries (tooth brush/ toothpaste / **100ml liquids maximum**)
- Towel
- Spending money (in both pounds sterling and euros) - students will be required to get lunch for themselves each day
- Packed lunch for the first day (due to the travelling time)
- Sun cream – must be 100ml or less
- Mobile Phone with charger
- European Travel adaptor
- Medication (please see below)

If your child will require any medication over the course of the trip then please ensure this is given to Mrs Banning on Student Reception before **Wednesday 5 June**. The medication needs to be in the original box together with the instruction leaflet, showing the child's name, clear instructions of when, how often and the dosage to be taken. If it is in liquid form, please provide dispenser (plastic spoon or syringe). If your child requires the use of an inhaler, please can you ensure they have this for the duration of the trip.

Please be aware any personal possessions including mobile phones will be the students' own responsibility and are not covered within the travel insurance. There is an EMERGENCY contact number for whilst the students are away, which can be contactable from 12 noon until 12 midnight on Monday 10 June – Friday 14 June. Please can you only use this number in the event of an emergency.

Outbound flight with Ryanair students are permitted a 10kg cabin bag (55cm x 40cm x 20cm) **plus** a small handbag or rucksack. **However** we are flying back with EasyJet who only allow a single cabin bag of 10kg (55cm x 40cm x 20cm)
