ECO Day Walesby Forest Adventure Park - Friday 21 September 2018

As part of Friday's ECO (Extending Curriculum Opportunities) programme your child will be involved in our external visit to the Walesby Forest Adventure Park where he/she will be participating in a range of outdoor activities aimed at developing communication and team work skills. Following on from the original letter and payment received by yourself I just wanted to remind, confirm and add to the detail given out in this earlier communication and so make sure that you and your child knows exactly what is happening on the day.

Preparing for the Day

Students need to come to school in sensible non-school uniform that is appropriate for participating in a range of outdoor physical tasks. The students will potentially get dirty while involved in the day, so please be mindful of this when selecting clothing. Walking boots or trainers are ideal and layered clothing appropriate for any weather conditions. A coat is essential as students will be based outdoors all day. As this is an all-day event students will need to bring a packed lunch or, if they are in receipt of a free school meal, then one will be arranged through the canteen and handed out on the Friday morning.

Friday Morning Arrangements

8:45am	all students to go to their normal Friday Period 1 teaching room for registration
8:55am	students will be dismissed to meet our lead activity organiser Mr Daniels and his team students will then head down to the Walesby bound buses with their group leader
9:00am	buses will depart from The Carlton Academy

During the day the students will be working with trained outdoor recreation specialists who will oversee the running of a variety of land based activities, following which everyone will return to the school at approx 3.15 pm.
