


# A Level Results

- 73% of our students progressed onto Higher Education in 2024.
- 94.4% A level pass rate.
- 15% achieved A\*-A grades.
- 45% achieved A\*-B grades (up from 39%)




# Entry Requirements

#### **Subject-specific:**

 Grade 6s are required for A Level Maths and Science and a minimum of a grade 4 for other subjects






