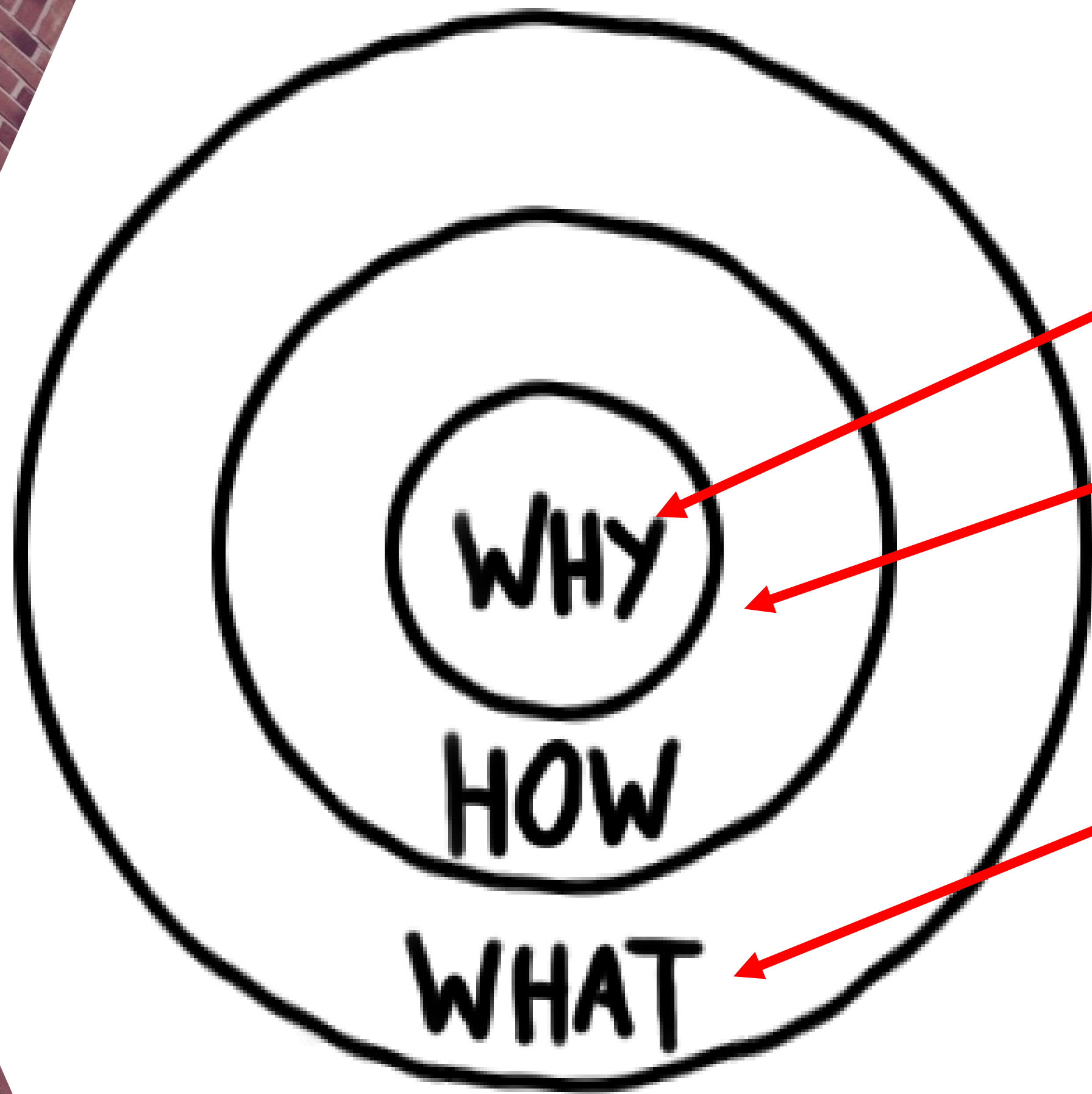

- 52.4% of A Level grades were at grades A* - B
- 98.1% pass rate in all A Levels

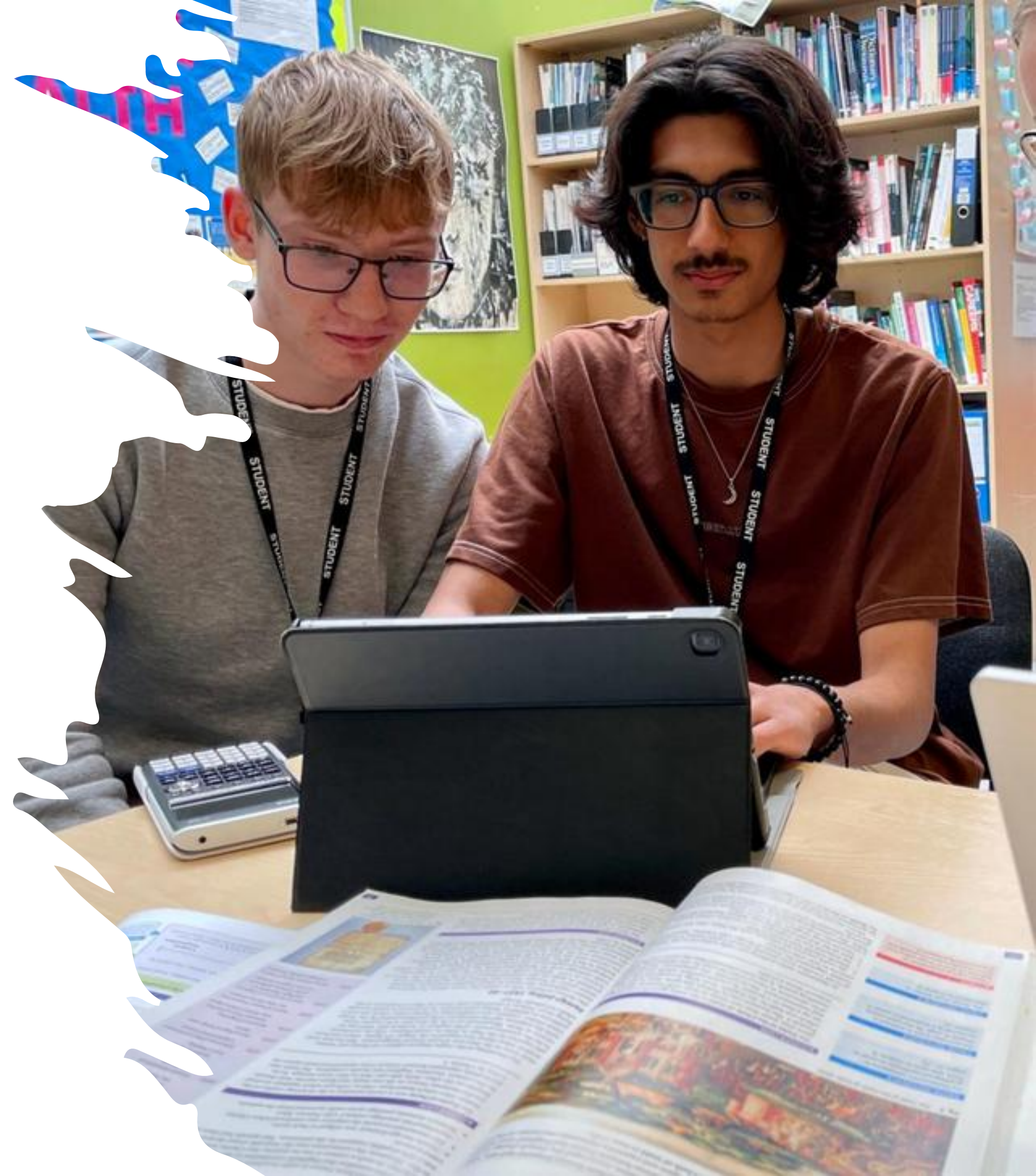


The benefits of our Sixth Form

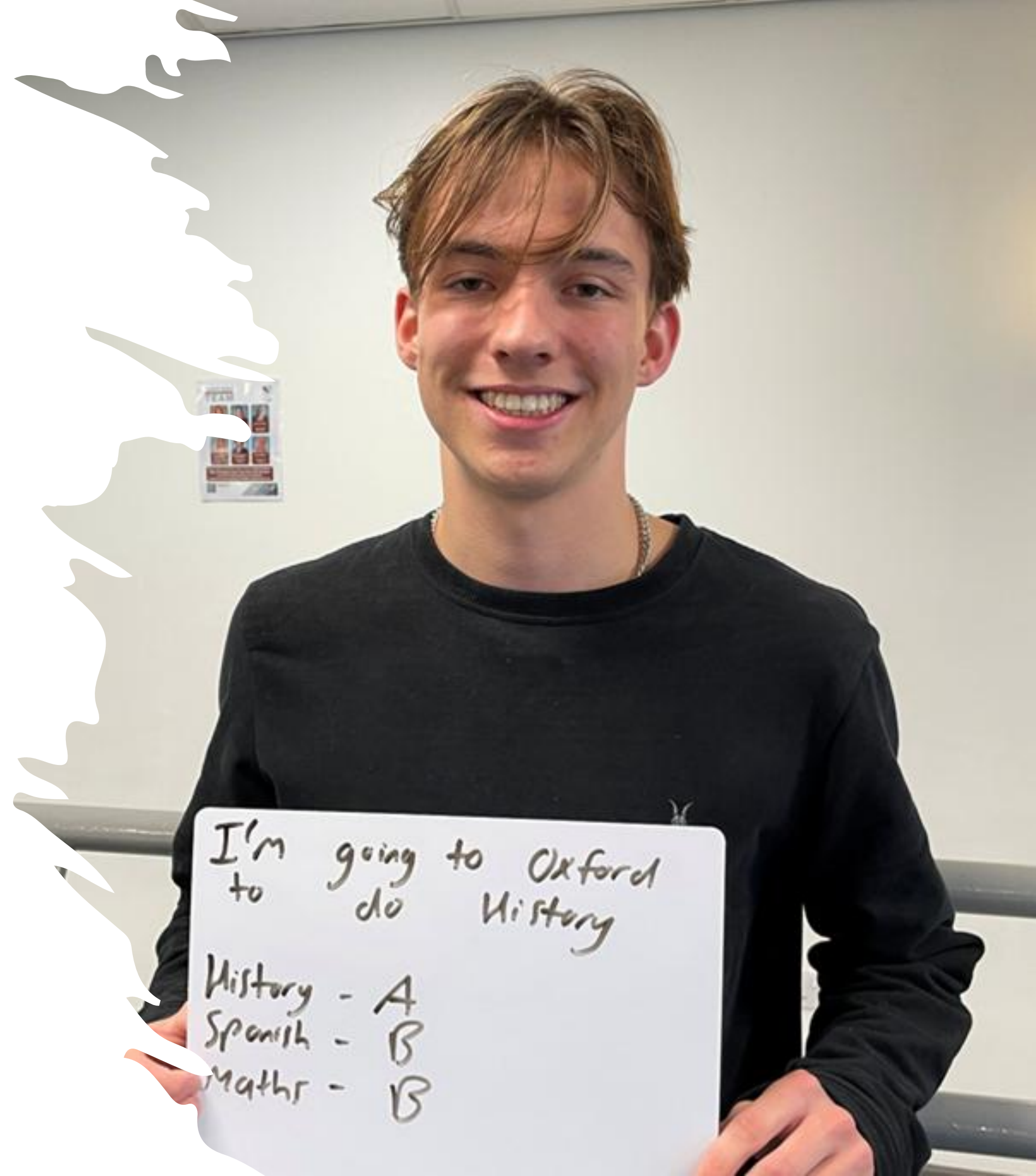
Entry Requirements

- At least five GCSEs at Grade 9-4, including English Language and/or Maths (preferably 5s in both)

Subject-specific:

- Grade 6s are required for A Level Maths and Science and a minimum of a grade 4 for other subjects
