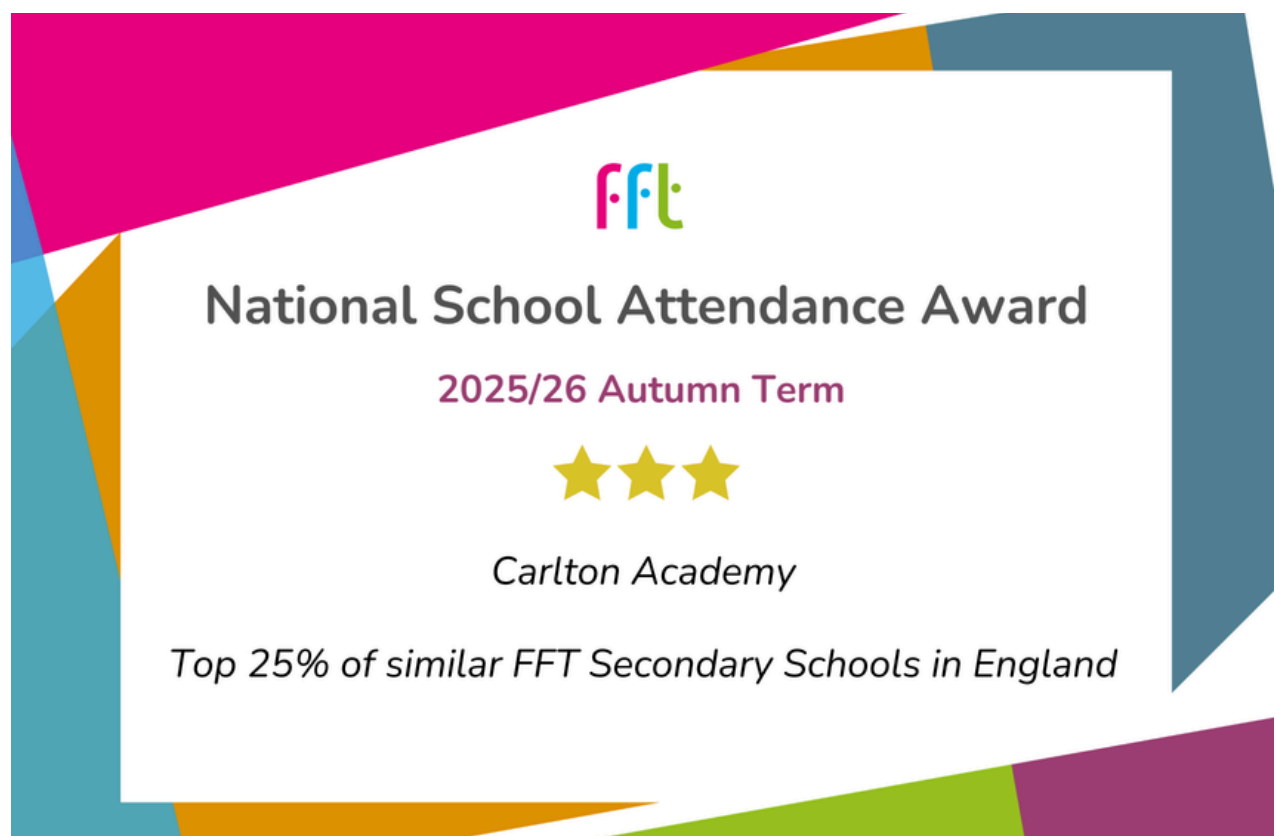
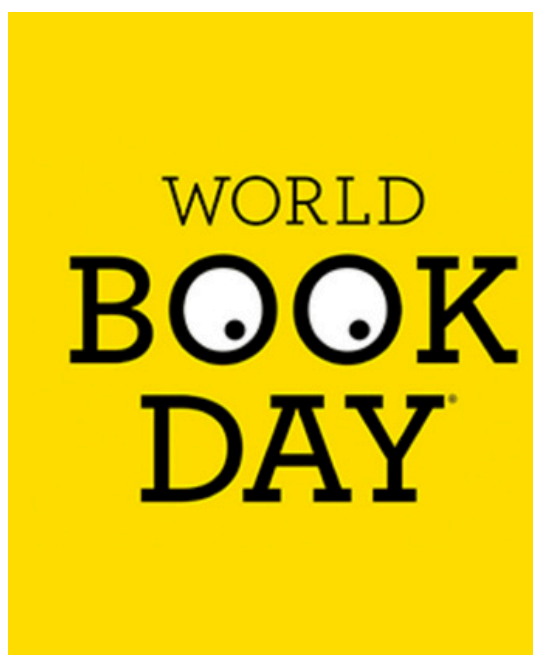
This week's activities

On Wednesday 25 February, industry representatives visited The Carlton Academy to give students the chance to explore a wide variety of workplaces, roles and career pathways. It was a fantastic opportunity for students to ask questions, gain real-world insight and to start thinking about their future options.



National Space Centre

We are thrilled to share the highlights of our recent science trip to the National Space Centre in Leicester, which was an unforgettable experience for our Year 7 pupils. The trip was packed with engaging activities and learning opportunities that left everyone inspired and eager to explore the wonders of space further.

Our visit began with a mesmerising planetarium show that took us on a journey through the cosmos. Students were captivated by the stunning visuals and learned about the formation of stars, galaxies, and the vastness of the universe.

We attended a workshop on how to live on Mars: In this hands-on workshop, students carried out a selection of experiments so that they could compare their results and discuss the relevance to future human inhabitants on Mars.

In the exciting and explosive Rocket show, pupils explored the history of rockets which gave them an excellent grounding in the principles behind launching rockets to space. Finally, the National Space Centre's interactive exhibits offered students the opportunity to engage with various aspects of space science. From learning about the history of space exploration to understanding the technology behind space missions, the exhibits were both educational and entertaining.
