- Opting in to learning, and persevering when it is challenging





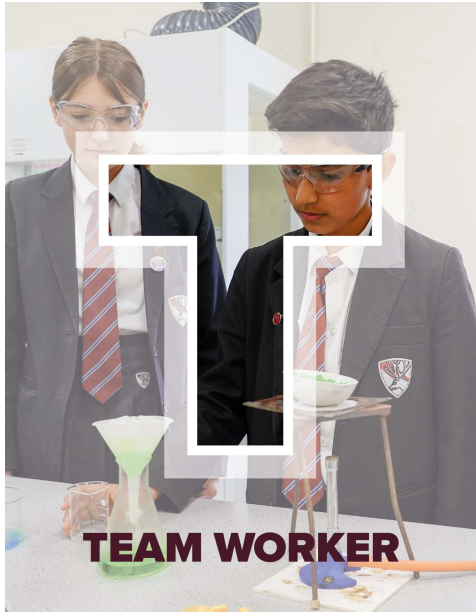
## **Leaders are:**
