

Lesson Support

Lesson support involves supporting a teacher in a lesson in a teaching assistant capacity. This will involve helping younger students in the lesson and it is your opportunity to use your expertise to help younger students reach their potential.

Department	Role	Description
English	Buddy Reading support with Y7 and Y8	A whole school priority at TCA is to increase reading ages across the school. Therefore, Sixth Form students are required to work with KS3 students to help them with their reading. KS3 students will be taken out of lessons to participate in paired reading. NOTE: Training will be given.
Maths	In-class support	This will involve helping and supporting students in KS3 (and potentially KS4) Maths lessons.
Science	In-class support	Sixth Form students will assist students in KS3 Science lessons
Humanities	In-class support	Sixth Form students will assist students in KS3 Humanities lessons
IT and Business	In-class support	Sixth Form students will assist students in KS3 IT and Business lessons. If these subjects were studied at KS4 then there is the opportunity to assist in KS4 lessons.
Art, Design and Technology	In-class support	This will involve helping in Art and DT lessons with year 11 students or KS3 lessons. You may also be responsible for offering support to the technicians in Art, Design and Technology.
Languages	In-class support	Sixth Form students will assist students in KS3 and KS4 Language lessons
PE	In-class Support	Sixth Form students will assist in KS3 and KS4 PE lessons
Social Science	In-class Support	This will involve helping students in KS4 Child Development or Psychology lessons

Additional opportunities can include EPQ, Duke of Edinburgh and leading/supporting with a lower school enrichment club. If you have an idea for an activity that is not already taking place then please speak to one of the Post 16 team so we can make it happen!
